Baptism of the Lord Sunday

Holy Baptism is one of the two sacraments recognized in the United Methodist Church. It is recognized because Jesus Christ participated in it himself as a way to acknowledge his humanity and to enter into God's presence, just as we do. Through baptism we are initiated into Christ's holy church and given new life and salvation. Today, we remember Christ's baptism by John the Baptist and recognize it as the beginning of Christ's ministry.

As we baptize our newest member, we also remember our own baptisms. We remember that we are Christ's body and disciples; we reaffirm our rejection of sin and commitment to Christ; and we renew our promise to participate in the ministries of the church. Just as Christ began His ministry, we welcome new baptized members into our community as they begin theirs.
