Please protect all of those around you by practicing social distancing, wearing masks and washing your hands.

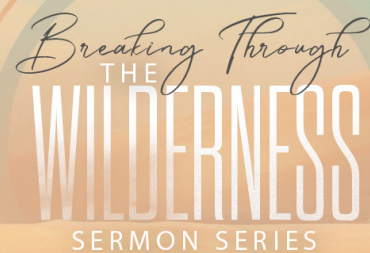
