Seeking to share the love and word of Christ with communities of Zimbabwe, Africa, while bringing them the gift of fresh water.

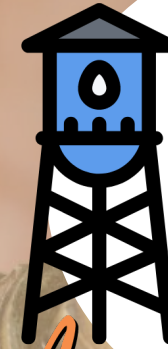

## Purpose

The Nyamakope Village Water Project raised funds to establish boreholes in rural villages of Zimbabwe, Africa. This mission trip aims to begin a cultural immersion with those communities and to spread the word and love of Christ to the people there. We seek to make a difference through participation in hands-on mission activities and to bring back more opportunities for missions to our congregation. The team will also participate in the dedication of the boreholes donated by our congregation.

## Where

The communities we plan to visit first are Nyamakope Village, Dzvingwe Village, and Mutoko Center in the Mutoko District of Zimbabwe, Africa. We will also visit the Home of Hope Orphanage at Nyadire United Methodist Mission Center, and the Mutemwa Leprosy Center in Mutoko District. We will then venture further to see Africa University in Mutare, Emsizini Mission School of the United Methodist Church in Bulawayo and lastly the mighty Victoria Falls all in Zimbabwe.

## When

We are proposing two options for when to do this mission trip. If we do not have school age participants, we would like to travel March 1-14, 2022. If we do have school age participants interested in going, the second option is to travel June 14-28, 2022 to accommodate school schedules. If there is enough interest, we may possibly do two trips, with both of these options. An itinerary will be provided as we get closer to the departure.

## Cost

The estimated cost of the trip is \$4000.00 per participant. This includes airfares, lodgings, meals, a safari, and ground transport in Zimbabwe. A deposit of \$500.00 is due by October 31st, 2021. The balance is due November 30th if the trip is in March 2022.

## Accommodations

We will stay at the following places:

- Suskwe Lodges - 4 days
- Rainbow Towers - 3 days
- Golden Peacock Villa Hotel, Mutare - 1 day
- Retreat Lodge & Conference Center, Bulawayo - 2 days
- Victoria Falls Lodge - 2 days
